

Other Illness Module

1. Access the CRMS Search Engine as described on page 16.
2. Locate the desired client by following instructions on page 50.

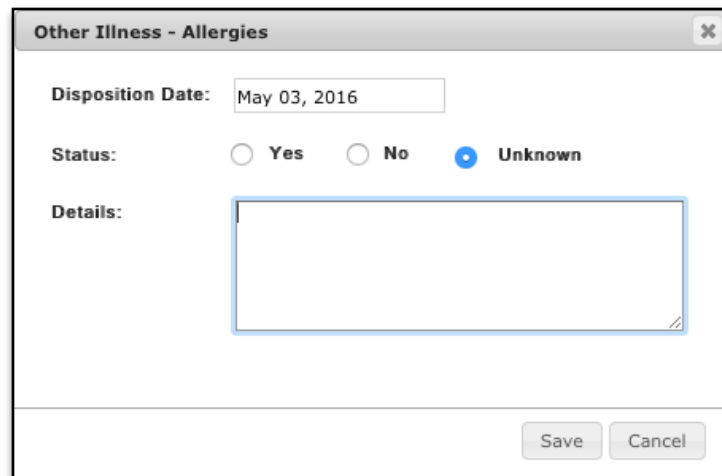
Figure 348 - Other Illness Module

3. Open the client file and navigate to the **Other Illness** module as shown in Figure 348.

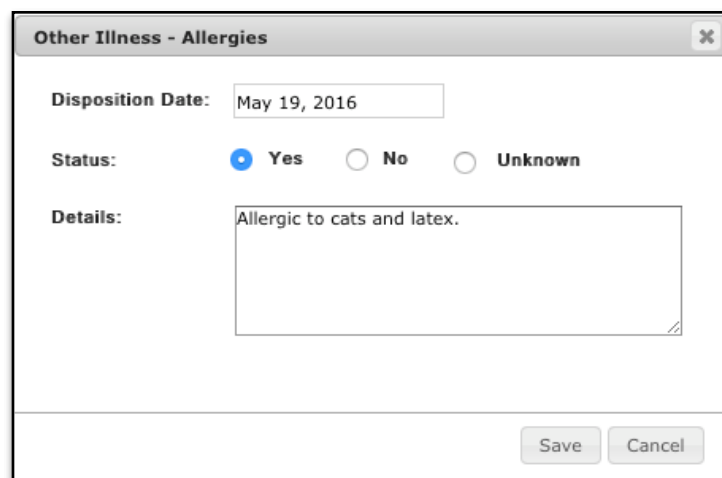
- Click on the desired row in order to bring up the editing dialog. A user has clicked on “Allergies” in Figure 350.

Show for All Admissions

When accessing a client file whom has multiple referrals (.01, .02, .03, etc.), users can use the “Show for All Admissions” checkmark to easily review across all referrals without the need to open each individual file.

1. Refer to page 161 on how to access the Other Illness module.
2. At the bottom of the module, locate and check the **Show for All Admissions** check mark as illustrated on Figure 354.
